*This exhibition is open to all professional, amateur and student photographers, artists, and poets submitting original works. **All submissions are expected to be submitted by the artists who created them and to be original in concept and design.***

### Fees

#### Adult Artists

##### **Art, Sculpture, and/or Photography**

3 entry maximum \$50.00

##### **Poetry entries from adult Art/Photography**

**Artists** (up to 3 poems) \$15.00

##### **Poetry Only**

Must be framed and wired.

3 entry maximum- \$30.00

#### High School Artists (Grades 9-12)

2 Entry maximum – Art, Sculpture, Photography or Poetry \$15.00

#### Student Artists (Grades K-8)

1 Entry maximum- Art, Sculpture, Photography or Poetry \$5.00

### Entry Information and Requirements

#### Photography Categories

Spotlight-**FLIGHT**, Architecture, Macro, Nature/Landscape, People, Photographic Art, Still Life, Wildlife/Animals

**Only 1 Spotlight entry allowed.**

#### Art Categories

Spotlight-**FLIGHT**, Acrylic, Digital, Drawing, Mixed Media, Oils, Pastels, Watercolor, Sculpture

**Only 1 Spotlight entry allowed.**

#### Entry Preparation and Requirements

- **Artist Biography.** We encourage artists to provide a brief (75-word max) bio with their application. Bios must be received by March 10.
- All hanging entries must be professionally presented and suitable for hanging, including framed with matting (all photo & poetry), gallery wrapped, Plexiglas, metal, etc.
- Each entry **must** have our identifying label (available on our current website - [stcatharts.org](http://stcatharts.org) - or with the paper application), filled out completely and attached to the back side of the entries.  
All work must be ready for hanging, complete with appropriate wire hanging support (i.e. screw eyes with wire, etc.).

# Patron of the Arts Association Guidelines

**Note: A fee of \$10.00 will be imposed to supply wiring materials at drop-off (not for metal). No Tape, String, Clips. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

- Entries are limited to **700 pieces**. Applications will be accepted until March 10, 2025, or until 700 entries are received, whichever comes first.
- In addition to your maximum entries submitted for judging, please consider donating to our **Silent Auction**. Identify any Silent Auction donations on the identifying label.
- Entries may not be removed until the end of the exhibition.
- All entries must be picked up on Sunday April 6<sup>th</sup> between 3:15 to 4:15. **No exceptions**. We will not be responsible for artwork left behind.
- Due to pastoral guidelines, we cannot accept any entry containing inappropriate or suggestive material. We reserve the right to reject pieces that depict nudity, violence, etc.

## Judging

- 1st, 2nd, 3rd place awards and Honorable Mention(s) will be given in each category. Additionally, each judge will assign a Judge's Choice Award.

- High School and Adult Poetry will be judged separately.
- Student K-8 entries are not judged, but each judge will select one Judges' Choice Award for this age group.
- Our Jubilee award will be given to one work of art, photography, and poetry that communicates the concept of Hope. What gives you hope in the midst of trial and uncertainty? How do you experience hope?"
- Silent Auction submissions are not judged.
- Winners will be notified via email as soon as possible after the judging. **Winners are asked to supply a jpeg of their piece(s) for our website announcement.**

## Sales

- A 25% minimum donation is required on all sales and any commissioned work.
- Artists whose works have sold will receive a check within approximately 45 days.

## Liability

- All submissions will be handled with reasonable care.
- The Patron of the Arts Association shall not be responsible for damage, loss or theft. Submitting an entry in this exhibition shall imply agreement on the part of photographer, artist, poet and sculptor with all the conditions outlined in this prospectus.
- Winning entries will be posted on our website in non-reproducible form.
